Basic Adult Leader Training

What is it? “This is Scouting”, “Youth Protection Training” and “Fast Start” Training are the first steps for any new volunteer. Immediately after a new leader registers and receives their membership card, they should go online, register on MyScouting.org and complete these E-Learning modules (see attached MyScouting & E-Learning explanation sheet). “This is Scouting” and “Youth Protection Training” are found on the “General” tab. “Fast Start” Training for Cub Scout various adult leader positions are found on the “Cub Scout” tab. “Fast Start” Training for all Boy Scout adult leaders is found on the “Boy Scout” tab.

To complete basic training, Cub Scout adult leaders (all positions) attend Cub Scout Leader Specific Training and Boy Scout adult leaders attend either Boy Scout Scoutmaster & Assistant Scoutmaster Training (along with Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills) or complete “Troop Committee Challenge” online at MyScouting.org’s E-Learning site (if they are primarily Troop Committee Members).
