



The Trainer's EDGE

- What is it?** This adult training develops your skills as a trainer and presenter. The purpose of Trainer's EDGE is to provide and develop the skills of a trainer. Only practice can polish these skills, but the course is intended to "train the Trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.
- Who?** Any registered adult Scouter who would like to increase their skills as a trainer/presenter in either the Scouting arena or in your personal life. This will help you if you make better presentations whether it's in front of your Scouts at a meeting, as a Merit Badge Counselor, Church meeting, Business presentations and so forth. This course is required for you to be a certified Council/District Trainer.
- When & Where?** Saturday, **February 20, 2010 from 8am to 4pm.** The training will be held at the Scout Service Center.
- Cost?** Fee is \$15 per person. Registration fee includes breakfast snacks, lunch, handouts, supplies, and graduation Certificate of Completion.
