

Introduction to Leadership Skills Course

The purpose of this course is to improve the leadership skills of all boy/girl leaders within a Boy Scout Troop and Venturing Crew. This training is one of several programs available within the youth leadership training program. Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops replaced Troop Leadership Training (TLT) in 2010. TLT was preceded by the Scoutmaster Junior Leader Training in use from 2000 to 2003. Training focuses on what a new Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader, Crew Leaders must know, must be, and must do. When the youth completes the course, he/she is qualified to wear the "Trained" patch on his/her shirt sleeve under the badge of office. **Completion of this course is a prerequisite to attend National Youth Leadership Training.**
