

# Wilderness First Aid Training

Wilderness First Aid is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definitive care by a physician and/or rapid transport is not readily available. This course goes far beyond what you may know as “first aid”. After completing this course, you will be better prepared in a remote situation. At least one person in a Philmont Trek is required to complete this course but it’s open to any adult who wants this certification.
