This class is conducted by experts in the field of Environmental Science in both the academic setting and the real world. While earning the Environmental Science merit badge, Scouts will get a taste of what it is like to be an environmental scientist, making observations and carrying out experiments to investigate the natural world. Environmental Science is one of the required merit badges for the World Conservation Award for Boy Scouts, and one of the required merit badges for the William T. Hornaday Awards for Boy Scouts.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Registration takes place online. Please visit www.goldenspread.org and click on "Environmental Science Merit Badge Online Registration".
- Registration is typically made by the Troop but if the Troop is not going, the parent may register the Scout. In the case of Troop registration, there must be at least two registered leaders for every 10 Scouts. If the parent is registering the Scout individually, the parent/guardian must attend OR make arrangements for another leader to provide supervision to the Scout as needed.
- In order to register and pay for your Scouts, you will need to know how many Scouts will be attending.

* Discount early bird fee until October 27, then \$55 after that date but **all registration ends on November 1**. Fees must be paid within 3 days after registration to keep your slots. Adult fee covers lunch but is optional. Adults are Free to attend the event!

Important Information

- ◆ This will be an outdoor event- no classroom instruction! Everything will be hands on! All requirements will be completed.
- ◆ This is a rain or shine event.
- ◆ Bring a hat and camera (if you want to take photo's)
- ◆ Bring a small clipboard and pen
- ◆ Bring a change of pants (you might get wet taking samples)
- ◆ Bring a change of shoes (NO open toe shoes will be allowed)
