



**2009 GE/QP Fall Camporee**  
**Friday, October 9 – Sunday, October 11**  
**Camp Don Harrington**

**What is it?** District event where Boy Scouts participate in skill competitions and Webelos participate in non-competition activities. Events will feature standard scout skills (as required for Tenderfoot, Second Class and First Class Rank Advancement). This year’s events include:

- **Sniper Competition:** 5-.22 rounds (only the best target will count for each patrol)
- **Target Archery:** best score for 5 arrows in target 25 feet away
- **Blast Away:** bust 5 clays on the sporting clays range
- **Cloud Archery:** best arrow shot at target 150 yards away
- **Wynne’s Wall:** everybody needs to get over the wall in good time
- **The Bomb:** Patrol chili cook-off for scouts only
- **Dutch Oven Cobble:** the name says it all
- **Dead Man’s River:** swing away and get everybody across the river
- **Chariot Race:** lash together your “chariot” and make it through the obstacle course
- **String Burning:** gather your kindling and wood and fire it up!
- **Scoutmanship:** what every scout should know about being a Scout
- **Blind Man’s Camp:** can you set up a jambo tent blindfolded?
- **A Bearing Mind:** follow the compass bearings and come up with the right word
- **Patrol Flag Competition:** bring and display your Patrol flag
- **Cool Campsite’s:** do you have a quality Patrol campsite?
- **BMX:** how many patrol members will make it across the finish line?
- **Egg Toss:** how far can you toss a raw one without making a mess?
- **Parton’s Mountain:** climb to the top as fast as you can
- **Enemy Encampment:** could be interesting
- **Knots to the Rescue:** how well can you tie a basic scout ?

**When & Where?** Friday, October 9 through Sunday, October 11. Check-in begins at 7 pm Friday night. Provision will be made so LDS units may leave Saturday night. Camporee will be held at Camp Don Harrington located approximately 5 ½ miles south of Hollywood/Loop 335 on east side of Washington/FM1541.

**Cost?** Fee is \$25 per person. Registration fee includes Saturday meals and Sunday breakfast, a patch for all participants and special recognition for each patrol. Refunds are not available, but fees are transferable to another scout or adult.
