



2012 Lone Wolf District Service Project Palo Duro Lake Clean-up

What is it? This program activity is a combination camp out and service project for all Packs, Troops and Crews.

When & Where? The lake clean-up begins at 10:00 am on Saturday, April 14, 2012. Your unit is invited to camp out Friday or Saturday night, or both nights! We will camp below the dam at Palo Duro Lake, near Spearman, Texas. (Take Hwy 15 East from Spearman about 5 miles to County Rd 28, then follow the signs, heading north.)

Supervision? If camping, all Cub Scout Packs that camp must follow BSA Family Camping guidelines (each Cub Scout must be accompanied by a parent, at least one adult pack leader on-site must be BALOO trained). All participating units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection guidelines and at least one adult must be Youth Protection Trained.

Cost? There is no cost for the camp out or clean-up, but each unit will have to provide and cook their own food. Palo Duro River Authority will be providing the Saturday lunch. Event patches will be provided, free of charge.

Registration: Pre-registration will enable us to determine how many trash bags we will need and to be able tell the Lake Authority how many people will be camping. Please return the registration form by **Monday, April 9, 2012**.
