### 2. Timetable

This year's popcorn sale will be September 26 through October 23, 2009. Note: Units may only sell during the timeframe listed. Units will pick up their ordered popcorn on Saturday, November 7th.

### 3. Popcorn Ordering

Scouts will take orders from family, friends and door-to-door. Your unit will then tally the sales and place your order with the Council. Units will order popcorn by containers sold. Your unit will pick-up your ordered popcorn from your district's distribution site. Scouts deliver the popcorn to their customers and collect monies. Your unit keeps its "commission" and turns in a check for the amount due to a Council Service Center.

## 4. Commission Structure

There are two programs your unit will need to choose from.

Plan 1. Your unit participates in the “Individual Prize Program” where Scouts earn prizes based on the total dollars of popcorn sold. Scouts may then choose from a wide range of prizes.

Plan 2. Your unit chooses the “Money Only Option” which gives you a higher commission. No Council prizes are available to units choosing this option.

## 5. Free Popcorn Patches

All Scouts selling popcorn will receive a free Trail’s End popcorn patch. This offer is open to all Scouts selling popcorn regardless of unit’s commission selection.

## 6. “Fill it up!” Program

Any Scout that completes an order form with 25 orders will receive a “*Fill it up!*” patch and certificate.

## 7. Individual Prize Program • Commission Plan 1

The Individual Prize Program is only available to those units selecting Plan 1 in the Commission Structure. A prize brochure is available for your Scouts to help them select a prize they would like to earn. Your Scouts earn prizes based on the total dollars they sell. The more popcorn sold the bigger and better prize he can receive.

## 8. The \$750 Club

Every Scout that sells a minimum of \$750 of popcorn will be invited to participate in a special activity. All qualifying Scouts will be able to attend a swimming and pizza party at the West Texas A & M’s indoor swimming pool on Saturday, January 30, 2010 from 2:00 pm until 5:00 pm.

## 9. \$1,500 Program

Every Scout who sells \$1,500 worth of popcorn will receive a \$50 Gift Card from Wal-Mart. This offer is open to all Scouts selling popcorn regardless of unit’s commission selection.
